Need help taking care of your lawn?? Here is a plan that I use to keep track of the TLC a Fescue lawn needs in our climate. I have been following it for almost 2 years and it has been working very well! Wanted to pass it along to help those who want it. Chris Zanagra

#### August 9end of month)

- Fertilize—Scotts with Summer Guard (orange bag)
- Grub Control

#### September

- Aerate
- Overseed
- Start Fertilizer

#### October

- Fertilize—Scotts Winter-Guard (red bag)
- Ironite (2—40lb bags)
- Lime (4—40 lb bags)

#### December

- Winter Liquid Weed Control—Bayer All-in-one Lawn Weed & Crabgrass Killer (Spray)

#### February

- Haltz Crabgrass Preventer

#### March

- Fertilize—Scotts Southern Turf Builder & Pre-emergent
- Ironite (2—40lb bags)

- Lime (4—40lb bags)

#### May

- Fertilize—Scotts w/PLUS 2 (yellow bag)
- Insect and Grub Control
- Bayer Complete Insect Killer
- Fungicide if wet or signs of brownpatch

#### July

- If broadleaf weeds—Bayer All-in-one Lawn Weed &

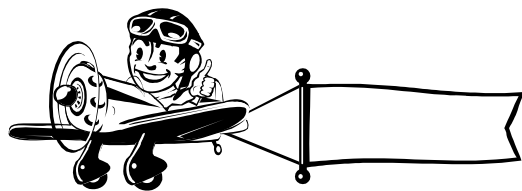

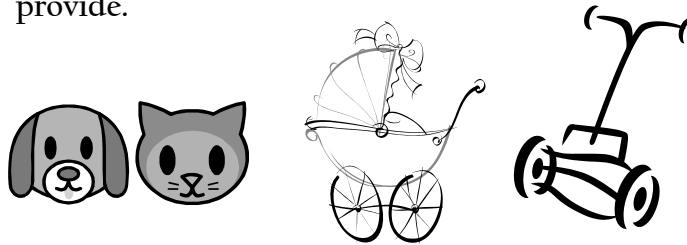

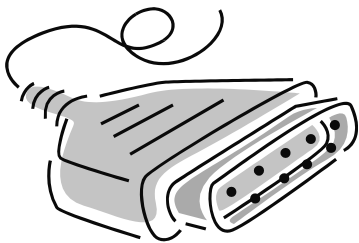
